



Part-time Surveyors Needed for Nadaka Community Survey in Rockwood

Background: The Columbia Slough Watershed Council, Audubon Society of Portland, and the Friends of Nadaka are looking for qualified candidates to work 10 hours a week helping conduct a community survey at Nadaka Nature Park between July 28 to August 22. The goal of the survey is to collect information on how people are using the park and the types of programs or events they would like to have present at Nadaka. Nadaka Nature Park is located at 17615 NE Glisan St. next to St. Aidan's Church.

Job Description: Intercept surveyors will survey park users of Nadaka Nature Park about their use of the park, what features bring them to the park, and what types of activities and opportunities they desire for the park. Job would pay minimum wage (\$9.25/hour). Surveyors will be contract staff with Columbia Slough Watershed Council and report to Nadaka Park Coordinator and work under the guidance of Audubon Society of Portland staff. Surveyors will be paid after completion of all work after August 22.

Job Requirements:

- Available to work 10 hours a week for four weeks between July 29 to August 22 on Wednesday, Thursday, Friday, and Saturday. Surveyors will work 2.5 hours a day on shifts between 7am and 7pm. An additional 4 hours of paid time will cover training on July 28 and additional time for survey coordination.
- Punctuality. Being on time and prepared (rain or shine) is critical for this job.
- Surveyors must be 16 years or older.
- Good listening and speaking skills.
- Being able to track details.

Other Desired Qualifications:

- Enthusiastic about parks, nature, being outdoors, and community service.
- Interested in learning how to conduct community surveys.
- Bilingual in English and either Spanish, Russian, or Somali.
- Clear handwriting.
- Resident of East Portland, Gresham, Fairview, Wood Village or Troutdale or a regular park user.
